- Allow for the 'chi' or energy of your message to flow throughout your site. If you have a weak area go in and work on it to help it to integrate into the rest of the site easily and effortlessly with correct linking, good visual design and a strong message.
- This is an obvious use for the Feng Shui search ranking tool and one which many pepople have already discovered. But... just as many have not and if you are one of those, making your site flow will improve it for your readers and drive traffic and business in your direction.

Color me happy!

- Use of color is important on a website. It must be easy for the reader to understand your text and using dark, murky colors in the background disturb the senses and chase folks away. Choosing colors that represent your industry is one great way to go. Also consider colors in your web design artwork that are clear, crisp and comforting.
- Best to choose a background color that is either white or a soft cream or other pleasing pastel. Black font is always the best, or dark blue or green for contrast. Choose a font that is clean and simple and a point size that all ages can take in. There's nothing more off-putting than—finding a great website and getting there only to discover you can't read the font because it's too small. Remember, the majority of the population wears glasses. Make it legible.
- And speaking of legible, make sure not to use a black background with white or yellow text. It's
 impossible to read.
- So many sites are unoriginal and boring to look at. Be creative in choosing your color scheme and
 if color is not your thing, ask for help from your friends or hire a web designer with a good graphics background. Better still, hire a Feng Shui consultant to help you decide on colors and format
 for your site.

Ding dong, bells, whistles and zap!

- Another piece of good advice in utilizing this creative search ranking tool is to keep flash and trash to a minimum. Flashing bells and whistles may attract attention, but more than likely they will also repel the reader and compel him to click away from your site as quickly as possible due to the visual distress caused by these gimmicky tricks.
- Smooth, gentle lines and visually flowing movement throughout your pages will encourage folks to stay on. Stay way from hard edges, pointed arrows and sharp visual barbs. If you do have pointed graphics or points in your logo, be sure they don't point to your business name or anything really important you want to say.
- Use Feng Shui to help you create a restful place for the eyes, a focal point of stillness. Having your logo appear on every page, along with a pleasing photo or an artful piece of eye candy for your viewers to rest their eyes upon, can greatly enhance the look and feel of your site.
